



# FREE PATTERN

Finished Size: approx. 3cm (1.2 inch) tall



- Light worsted yarn (4 ply)  
(I used Piccolo yarn from Japan)
- 2.25 mm (size B) and  
2.75mm (size C) crochet hook
- 5 mm safety eyes
- Soft stuffing (such as polyester fiberfill)
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker
- Scissors

## WHAT YOU NEED

- ch : chain
- sc : single crochet
- st/sts : stitch(es)
- slst : slip stitch
- inc : increase (2sc in one st)
- dec : decrease (sc next 2sts together)
- MR : magic ring

# MAIN BODY

*\*Start with the color of the bird that you desire to make.\**

R1.	6 sc into the MR	(6)
R2.	(inc) 6x	(12)
R3.	(sc, inc) 6x	(18)
R4.	sc in all sts	(18)
R5.	(inc, sc 16, inc)	(20)
R6.	(inc, sc 18, inc)	(22)
R7.	(sc 10, inc 2x, sc 10)	(24)
R8.	sc in all sts	(24)
R9.	(inc 2x, sc 9, inc 2x, sc 9, inc 2x)	(30)

*\*Change the color. Insert 5mm safety eyes between R7-R8, about 5sts apart. Start stuffing the body, continue as you go.\**

R10.	sc in all sts	(30)
R11.	(inc 3x, sc 24, inc 3x)	(36)
R12.	sc in all sts	(36)
R13.	(dec 3x, sc 24, dec 3x)	(30)
R14.	(dec) 15x	(15)
R15.	(dec 3x, sc 3, dec 3x)	(9)
R16.	(sc, dec) 3x	(6)

*\*Finish off, add a little more stuffing, and then sew up the hole.\**



# COLOR OF YARN

## COCKATIEL



**Baby Yellow**  
(for body and tuft)  
**Grey**  
(for body, wings, tail)  
**Pink** (for beak)  
**Orange** (for cheeks)

## YELLOW PARAKEET



**Yellow**  
(for body and wings)  
**Green**  
(for body and tail)  
**Pink** (for beak)  
**Black** (for wings)



## BLUE PARAKEET



**White** (for body)  
**Blue**  
(for body, wings, tail)  
**Yellow** (for beak)  
**Black** (for wings)

## GALAH



**Baby Pink**  
(for body and crest)  
**Pink** (for body)  
**Yellow** (for beak)  
**Grey**  
(for wings and tail)



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# WINGS

*\*Use 2.75mm crochet hook. And crochet yellow and black yarns together or blue and black yarns.\**

R1.	6 sc into the MR	(6)
R2.	(inc) 6x	(12)

*\*Fold, so that 9 stitches line each other in 2 layers. Slip stitch both layers to close it (about 9 slst). Finish off, leave a long tail for sewing. Sew it to the side of the body between R8-R11.\**



# WINGS

(EXCEPT FOR PARAKEET BIRDS)

*\*The color of the yarn that you need is **depend on what bird** you want to make.\**

| R1. | 6 sc into the MR | (6)  |
| R2. | (inc) 6x         | (12) |
| R3. | (sc, inc) 6x     | (18) |

*\*Fold, so that 9 stitches line each other in 2 layers.  
Slip stitch both layers to close it (about 9 slst). Finish off,  
leave a long tail for sewing. Sew it to the side of the body  
between R8-R11.\**



## TIPS

Position the wings  
slightly to the  
upwards, about 2sts  
apart from the eyes.



# BEAK

*\*The color of the yarn that you need is **depend on what bird** you want to make.\**

- R1. Ch 3  
start from 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook  
sc, inc (in back loops of foundation chain), turn  
inc, sc (in front loops of foundation chain), turn  
slst to the first sc (6)

*\*No need to stuff. Sew the beaks between the eyes, about R6-R8. **Pinch the beak frequently** while you're sewing, to maintain the shape so it won't lay flat.\**

# TAIL

*\*The color of the yarn that you need is **depend on what bird** you want to make.\**

- R1. 6 sc into the MR (6)  
R2. (sc, inc) 3x (9)  
R3. sc in all sts (9)

*\*Stuff it lightly. Sew it to the back of the body (to the inclined part) between R9-R12.\**



# DETAIL OF GALAH

## CREST

*\*Make 3. Use baby pink yarn.\**

R1. ch 5

*\*Finish off, leave a long tail for sewing. Sew it to the head, start from R3 of the front part of the head to R3 of the back part of the head. Sew the other two to the left and right side of the first crest.\**



*Embroider the eyelashes using a black thread.*



# DETAIL OF PARAKEET

*\*Embroider the line under the eyes, between R8-R10. Use the green yarn for Yellow Parakeet and blue yarn for Blue Parakeet.\**



# DETAIL OF COCKATIEL

## CHEEKS

*\*Use orange yarn.\**

R1. 4 sc into the MR (4)  
slst

*\*Sew it to the body, just under the eyes  
between R8-R10.\**



## TUFF

*\*Take 2 short strands of baby yellow yarn and  
use your crochet hook to pull them through  
the R1 and R2 of the head to form a loop.  
Then tie in a knot and trim to desired length.\**
